

**MONDAY VIRTUAL ALL STAR SWISS RATED OPEN #34:  
Game 15, d5**

**WHEN:** Monday, April 12, 5:00-7:00 PM

**WHERE:** Online at [LiChess.org](https://lichess.org). In order to be eligible to play in our Swiss Rated Tournaments, you must join our new, free Lichess Online Club, Championship Chess Swiss All Stars (<https://lichess.org/team/championship-chess-all-stars>)

**FORMAT:** 4 Rounds Swiss Pairings (4 SS), Game 15, plus Increment adds 5 seconds each move. Note: If you don't make your first move in 20 seconds the computer assumes you are not available and will remove you from the tournament. You may return but your game that round is over.

**ENTRY FEE:** \$15/player, until Sunday at 6PM, then \$25.

**BYES:** If you arrive late, after Round #1 starts, you receive an automatic half point bye in round #1. If you leave and miss a round you receive zero for rounds missed but you can return.

**SPORTSMANSHIP:** We want to promote the fun of competition and good sportsmanship in these tournaments, so keep chats nice.

**Register and Pay** by going to [www.championshipchess.net](http://www.championshipchess.net) and click Register/Tournament (<https://championshipchess.net/tournaments/tournamentregister/?id=-1>). Select "Monday Virtual All Star Open #34."

When registering, please enter "LiChess Screen Name" in place of First Name. This is an Open Tournament. **NOTE:** Since we often register Scholastic players, if you have completed High School, put your information in both Parent and Child areas. List your School as "Adult" and your grade as 99.

**DON'T FORGET:** Registering online at [www.championshipchess.net](http://www.championshipchess.net) does NOT get you into the Championship Chess Swiss All Stars, the "club" that you must join to play in our Tournaments. Go to Championship Chess Swiss All Stars (<https://lichess.org/team/championship-chess-all-stars>) to complete your registration Monday's tournament and be ready to play.

These are meant to be fun events with only a few dollars in them to draw in some better players. 75% of entries are paid out to top players. In recent tournaments prizes were often just \$30, \$25, \$20 and many at \$15, covering entry fees.
