Chess Camp at the Solarium is open to any rising 1st-7th grade child, from non-player to those who already can play a full game. Beginners will build basic skills with special pre-chess (no king) games to practice how the pieces move, capture, and work. Players will learn to start the game with an advantage using opening strategies that will keep opponents on the defensive. Endgame and tactical skills will be taught to strengthen campers play. Players will improve skills through lessons by our coaches and guided play, review of their own games as well as master games, and supportive video and online resources. A mini-tournament with clocks and notation will be a fun part of this exciting camp. Campers should bring snacks and water bottles or drinks.

Week 2: Week of July 5-8 (4 days) 8:30 AM – 12:30 PM

Skill Level: Campers must know how all pieces move and capture. No beginners this session.

Week two Chess Camp at the Solarium is a 4-day camp and it is open to any rising 1st-7th grade child who knows how all the pieces move and capture or can already play a full game. Players will learn new opening, middle and endgame skills through lessons by our coaches and guided play, learn to play in tournament mode using algebraic notation and chess clocks, review of their own games as well as master games, and supportive video and online resources. A Swiss System tournament with clocks and notation will be a fun part of this exciting camp. Campers should bring snacks and water bottles or drinks.
